

COMMON: Headache, muscle weakness, muscle heaviness, nausea, pain.

UNCOMMON: Bronchitis, nasopharyngitis, depression, insomnia, ptosis, syncope, paraesthesia, dizziness, oedema, blurred vision, tinnitus, dry mouth, pruritus, photosensitivity, muscle twitching, cramps, fatigue.

LOCALISED ALLERGIC REACTIONS: Rare, but can cause localised swelling, redness, itching and a rash. These can be simply treated with ice, antihistamines, topical steroids, or oral steroids as required. Localised allergic reactions may occur due to alcohol skin preparation.

SYSTEMIC REACTIONS: Extremely rare, but basic resuscitation equipment should be readily available including adrenaline at the very least.
